RISK MANAGEMENT

According to the Standards of Excellence:

- One session must be held per quarter.
- A majority of your chapter must attend.
- They can be administered by a qualified professional or by a qualified chapter officer or adviser; however, if a chapter officer administers the program justification for a knowledge base (such as a resource list) must be provided when turning in your Annual Chapter Report on March 1.
- Risk Management Programs are any educational programs that address relevant issues for the OSU Greek community including but not limited to issues of:
 - Alcohol and other Substance Abuses
 - Personal Safety
 - Fire Safety
 - Hazing
 - Rape Education and Prevention
 - Federal, State, Local, University, and Council Alcohol Policies.
- The goals of these programs should be to ensure that:
 - Every Greek member, and the Greek community as a whole, takes responsibility for the physical and emotional safety of every member and every guest at all times.
 - Chapters manage risks on their property and share responsibilities when on other properties throughout the Greek community.
 - Every member of the Greek community has a clear understanding of his or her chapter's risk management policies and procedures.
 - Every member of a chapter has the personal responsibility for maintaining a safe and healthy environment for academic pursuits and social interaction.
 - Every member of the Greek community has a clear understanding of state, local, University, and council policies.

The following online and programming resources are guidelines for possible programs, but are by no means a complete list. Please feel free to contact other organizations, including your own (inter)national organization, about other possible Risk Management Programs.



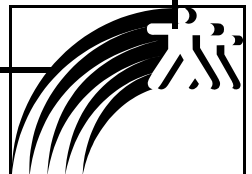
DIVERSITY EDUCATION

According to the Standards of Excellence:

- One session must be held per year.
- 75% of your chapter must attend sponsored event at the same time.
- Each chapter will educate its members on issues related to diverse populations identified by ethnicity, race, religious preference, gender, sexual orientation, or disability.
- A summary of the program or event must be included in the chapter's annual report due March 1. Chapters will be taken on their word that the participation percentage requirement was met.
- This must be a program/event with a focus other than one central to the organization.
- The goals of diversity-oriented programming are to ensure that:
 - Greek chapter members and the Greek community as a whole gain a greater appreciation, understanding, and acceptance of issues relating to diverse populations.
 - Greek chapter members participate in events and/or programs that promote respect and broaden member's knowledge base about diverse populations.
 - Allow Fraternity and Sorority members an opportunity to broaden themselves through experiential learning.

The following online and programming resources are guidelines for possible programs, but are by no means a complete list. Please feel free to contact other organizations, including your own (inter)national organization, about other possible Diversity Oriented programs.

Diversity can be defined as the manifestation of differences that exist in our society such as race, ethnicity, religion, socioeconomic status, gender, religion and persons with disabilities. The challenge of diversity is to acknowledge, affirm, and respect these differences.



COMMUNITY SERVICE

According to the Standards of Excellence:

- One session must be held per year.
- 75% of your chapter must attend sponsored event at the same time.
- A philanthropy event will not count for this requirement.
- The community service should engage the group's members in hands-on community service.
- A summary of the activity must be included in the chapter's annual report due March 1.
- Upon completion of the event, the chapter will furnish a letter from the foundation or organization documenting the service event.
- Additionally, members of Greek organizations are expected to take part in at least one hour of hands-on community service each year in a project of their own choosing that is not part of the chapter's group service requirement. A listing of the activities must be included in the chapter's annual report, but individual verification is on the honor system.
- Community Service is any activity that is hands-on community service in which chapter members donate their time.
- The goals of community service should be to ensure that:
 - Every Greek member, and the Greek community as a whole gains a greater understanding of the chapters' responsibility to community.
 - Every member of the Greek community uses hands-on service to foster a spirit of well-roundedness and personal responsibility through service-learning.
 - Every member of a chapter has the personal responsibility to provide volunteer hours to local community organizations and agencies.

The following online and programming resources are guidelines for possible programs, but are by no means a complete list. Please feel free to contact other organizations, including your own (inter)national organization, about other possible Community Service projects.

“Service-Learning occurs when students learn and develop through active participation in thoughtfully organized service that is conducted in and meets the needs of the community, including structured time for the students and community participants to reflect on and analyze the service experience.”

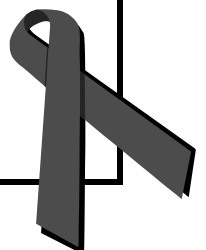

HEALTH AND WELLNESS

- Can be administered by a qualified professional or by a qualified chapter officer or adviser.
- Health and Wellness oriented programs are any educational programs that address issues of health awareness such as:
 - Eating Disorders
 - Cancer
 - AIDS Awareness
 - Physical Fitness
 - Safe Sex
- The goals of these programs should be to ensure that:
 - Greek members are educated on important health issues and are qualified to make educated decisions in situations that may affect their well-being.
 - Greek chapters, and the Greek community as a whole, foster an environment that promotes the development of sound mind and body of its members.

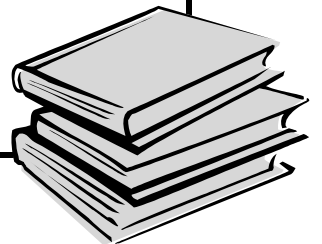

- Can be administered by a qualified professional or by a qualified chapter officer or adviser.
- Scholarship/Career oriented programs are any educational programs that address issues of academic and career success including but not limited to:
 - Study skills
 - Resume writing
 - Interviewing skills
 - Writing skills
- The goals of these programs should be to ensure that:
 - Specific academic goals for high standards and performance are established within every chapter.
 - The high academic expectations of the Greek community are supported by consistent support services that offer every fraternity and sorority student the best chance of success.
 - An integrated learning experience for Greek students is offered by each chapter combining traditional academic programs with life-skills and leadership development.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

- Can be administered by a qualified professional or by a qualified chapter officer or adviser.
- Leadership Development is any educational program that addresses the definition of leadership and its application.
- The goals of these programs should be to ensure that:
 - Every Greek member, and the Greek community as a whole, is prepared to take a leadership role in campus organizations outside of his or her chapter.
 - Chapters have an appreciation for different styles of leadership.
 - Every member of the Greek community has an understanding of his or her leadership style.

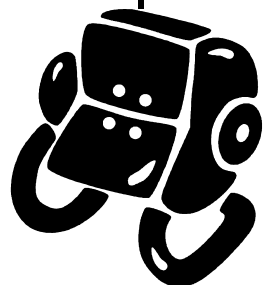
