- 3) Ohio Union Activities Board Update Casey Petrae, President
  - a) Welcome Week
    - Buckeye Kickoff had a huge turnout this year with over 7,000 students in attendance. We were able to bring the event back to its full potential for the first time since 2019 by being able to allow students on the field with the marching band, pre-event activities and full attendance numbers.
    - ii) This year we made the decision to discontinued campus locator booths as we have seen utilization of the booths start to drastically drop over the last several years with people just using cell phones.
    - iii) Other Events
      - (1) Free Money Game Show Night in Woody's Tavern: This event put on by the Special Events committee had hundreds of people turn out. It allowed for interaction between students and their roommates and overall was a successful event.
      - (2) Welcome Back Concert ft. JADEN: For the first time since 2019 OUAB was able to take the Welcome Back Concert to the Schottenstein Center featuring DJ Bandcamp and JADEN, the concert itself sold out of over 7,500 tickets within a few days and students loved it! The event was interactive, the talent was amazing and overall, it was a great morale boost for OUAB to be back to a large-scale event level in the Schott.
  - b) Homecoming
    - i) Homecoming week is next week! We are excited to Celebrate the 110th Annual Homecoming next week with events including AUX Chord Wars in the Ballroom to kick off the week, OUABreaking the Barrier with Tyler Lepley, the Annual Homecoming Parade which has over 60 entries of organizations and campus partners and we are excited to bring back the Homecoming Festival and Firework Display from last year for an event after the parade. We are so excited to celebrate Homecoming back in its full potential and this year it is themed to celebrate Ohio Stadium's 100th Year.

    - (1) Starting late last spring semester, the reorganization of units in Student Life took another big step when several former Student Activities programs (Leadership, Buck-I-SERV, Pay It Forward, Mount Leadership

Society, and Buckeye Social Entrepreneurship Program) were combined with Student Philanthropy and Buckeye Leadership Fellows to create a new unit called Leadership and Community Engagement. 6 full time staff members and 2 GTAs moved over to the new unit, which reports to Associate Dean of Students Kristen Rupert Davis.

- (2) Student Activities now has 13 professional staff positions (though 5 are currently vacant, 3 of those being brand new), 1 graduate associate, and about 30 undergraduate student employees. We support the community of registered student organizations, advise the Ohio Union Activities Board and the three student governments, and operate the KBKCSLS in our mission to "facilitate meaningful involvement, community engagement and leadership development, which enable all students to contribute to a global society."
- (3) Like the Ohio Union, Student Activities is part of the Student Engagement and Support area overseen by the Dean of Students and Associate VP for Student Engagement and Support, Dr. Danny Glassmann.
- (4) In CSA's recent review of the Student Activity Fee, 2 brand new professional staff positions were established – a Coordinator of Student Organizations, who will supervise our Student Org Success Coaches and support training and development initiatives for all student organizations, and a Coordinator of Student Governments, who will assist each of the three student governments in their day-to-day activities. Additionally, Student Life has created a new Student Activities position to focus on hazing prevention education and risk reduction for student organizations as part of our overall institutional efforts to combat hazing and enact initiatives related to Collin's Law.
- (5) These three positions are in various stages of the search and hiring process. Likewise, OUAB hired Devon Stith earlier this summer and is in the process of filling its two remaining vacant professional staff positions. We are also finalizing a promotion for Brooke Olson to become an Assistant Director of Student Organizations.
- ii) Campus Events
  - (1) We work closely with the Ohio Union Activities Board to coordinate their slate of programs, including their Graduate and Professional Student programming. We also assist with the CSA Signature Events process, providing support for the planners of those select programs that receive a special allocation from the Student Activity Fee. Student Activities also facilitates campus-wide information sharing and collaboration among departments within and outside of the Student Life that program student events.

- (2) Though we have returned to fully in-person programming, we are still working through the impact of the COVID pandemic (e.g., staff shortages, supply chain delays, increased costs of talent fees and event production). Nevertheless, attendance at events during the first four weeks of the semester has been exceptional, highlighted by more than 10,000 at the Student Involvement Fair, more than 7,000 at Buckeye Kick-off, and approximately 3,000 at OUAB's Welcome Back Concert featuring Jaden Smith.
- iii) Student Organizations
  - (1) Student Activities supports the registration and funding process for student organizations, including training for presidents, treasurers, and advisors, consultations for new and continuing groups, and the operation of the Keith B. Key Center for Student Leadership and Service and the Resource Room within the Center.
  - (2) The number of organizations that complete the registration process is calculated twice a year – once in fall and once in spring, corresponding with the two different registration windows we offer (based on when in the year the groups transition to new officers). Last year, the registration numbers rebounded from a COVID-influenced drop in 2020-2021. So far this year, we have seen a very high number of new groups engaging in the registration process and are poised to see well over 1,400 groups complete the process.
  - (3) Coming soon Buckeye Organization Leadership Development (BOLD) Conference – new half-day conference for student org members and leaders on October 23.
  - (4) Our new hazing prevention website launched today at http://stophazing.osu.edu. We will continue to grow these resources and services for student orgs and other student groups.
- iv) Student Governments
  - (1) Our team provides advisory, purchasing, and logistical support for the Undergraduate Student Government, the Council of Graduate Students, and the Inter-professional Council. After 20 years of advising USG directly, Matt Couch has passed the mantle on to Jen Pelletier, who began advising USG as the new administration took office in the spring. Kerry Hodak, formerly of Student Activities and most recently on the Buckeye Careers staff has also transitioned out of her advisory roles with CGS and IPC after many years, having taken a new position outside of Student Life. We look forward to welcoming a new colleague to Student Activities in a brand-new student government support role that will work with Jen, Teresa Kempton Dray, and Matt to support all three groups.
